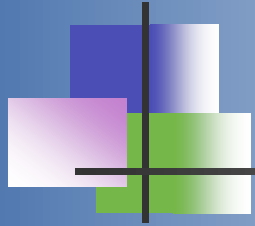

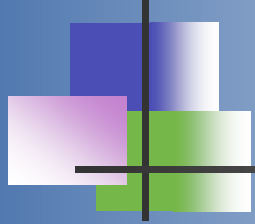

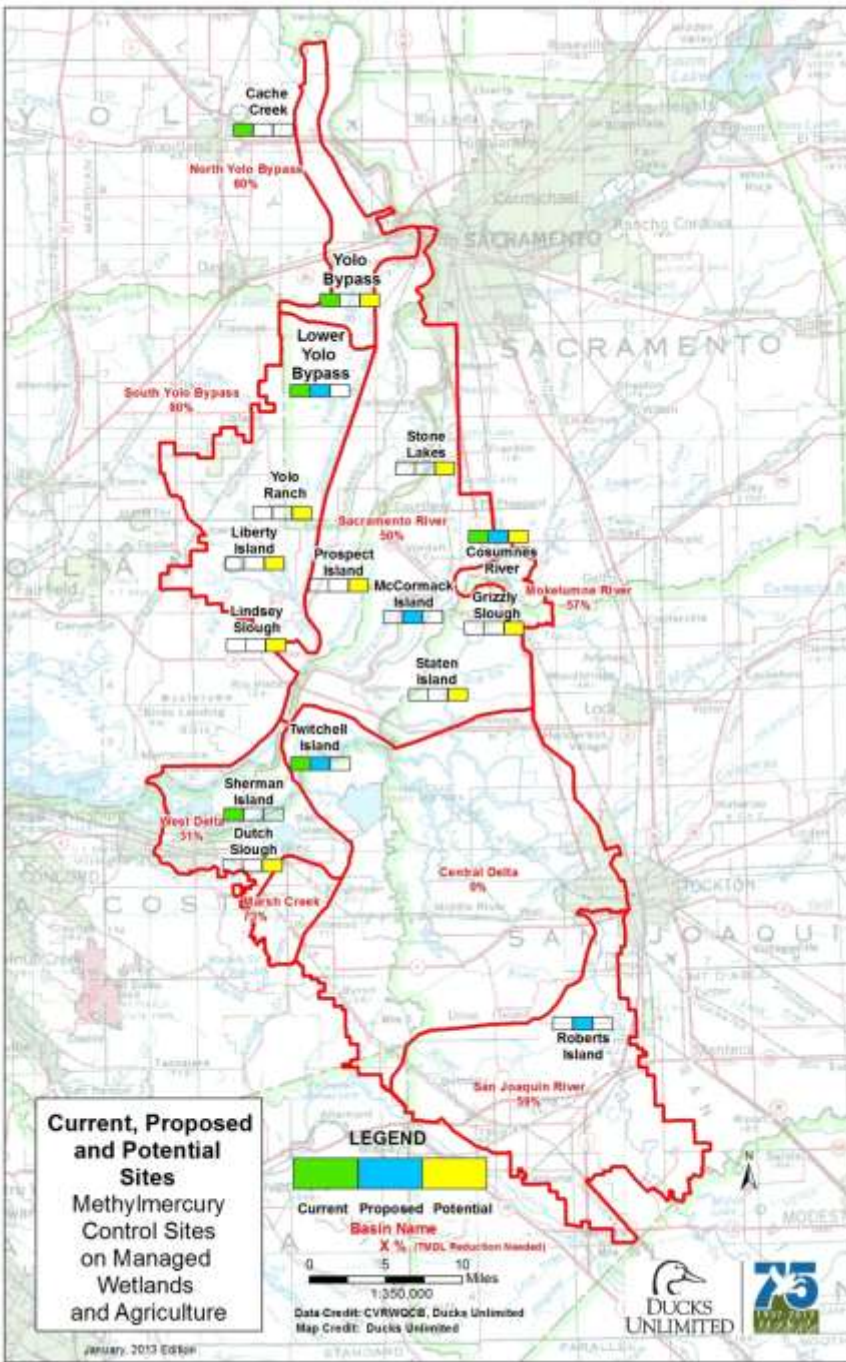

CONTROL STUDY SITES

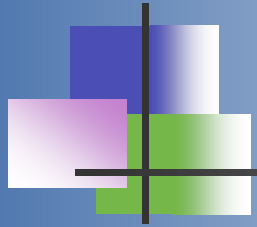
Control Study Sites (Updated)





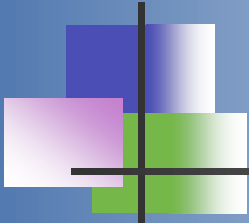

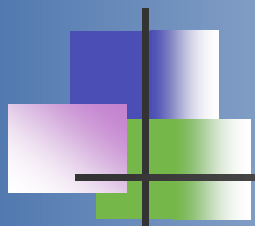
